

Ministerial Regulation B.E. 2539 (1996)**Sample of the Officer's Identity Card****Under the Energy Development and Promotion Act, B.E. 2535 (1992)****Translation**

The Minister of Science, Technology and Environment, by virtue of Section 12 Paragraph 2 and Section 41 of the Energy Development and Promotion Act, B.E. 2535 (1992), hereby issues the Ministerial Regulations as follows:

Clause 1

An identity card of the officer shall conform with the annex of this Ministerial Regulation.

Clause 2

An attached photo on an identity card shall have been taken for no longer than six months before the date of application for the identity card and its size is 2.5 x 3 centimeters, upper half and straight posture, in a government official uniform, a state enterprise uniform or a formal dress, and without a hat.

Clause 3

The Minister of Science, Technology and Environment shall be the issuer of the identity card of the appointed officer at level 10 and above.

Clause 4

The Director-General of the Department of Energy Development and Promotion shall be the issuer of the identity card of the appointed officer at level 9 and lower, and the appointed state enterprise officer.

Clause 5

An identity card of the officer shall be valid for a period as indicated on the card.
