

**The Ministerial Regulation, B.E. 2535 (1992)  
Issued Pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 (1992)**

**Translation**

By virtue of the provisions in Section 5, Section 6 and Section 7 of the Factory Act B.E. 2535, the Minister of Industry issues a ministerial regulation as follows:

**Article 1**

The factory under the type or kind specified in the list annexed hereto shall be the one under the Factory Act B.E. 2535.

**Article 2**

The factory under Article 1 shall be such factory of the first group, factory of the second group and factory of the third group as specified in the list annexed hereto.

**Note:** The reason for the enactment of this ministerial regulation is: Whereas the Factory Act B.E. 2535 has provided it that a ministerial regulation prescribing the type or kind of the factory that must be subject to this act shall be issued, and that the factory be divided into 3 groups, i.e. the factory of the first group can be engaged in the factory business immediately according to the factory business operator; the factory of the second group is subject to giving notice prior to engagement in the factory business, and the factory of the third group is subject to prior receipt of the license in order to be able to operate; so it is necessary to issue this ministerial regulation.
