

**Ministerial Regulation No. 16, B.E. 2545 (2002)**

**Issued Pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535**

**Translation**

By virtue of the provisions in Section 5, Section 6 and Section 7 of the Factory Act B.E. 2535, which is an act that contains some provisions about the limitation of the rights and freedom of a person, which Section 29 combined with Section 35, Section 48 and Section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand prescribes to be permissible by virtue of a legislation, the Minister of Industry issues a ministerial regulation as follows:

**Article 1**

The statement in (2) of Type or Kind of Factory in Sequence No. 3 of the List Annexed to the Ministerial Regulation (B.E. 2535) Issued Pursuant to the Factory Act B.E. 2535 shall be rescinded and the following statement shall apply instead:

**Article 2**

The statement in Sequence No. 18 of the List Annexed to the Ministerial Regulation (B.E. 2535) Issued Pursuant to the Factory Act, B.E. 2535 shall be rescinded and the following statement shall apply instead:

**Article 3**

The following statement shall be added as Sequence No. 107 of the List Annexed to the Ministerial Regulation (B.E. 2535) Issued Pursuant to the Factory Act, B.E. 2535:
