

**MINISTERIAL REGULATION ON THE
PRESCRIBING OF STANDARD FOR ADMINISTRATION
AND MANAGEMENT OF OCCUPATIONAL SAFETY,
HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT IN RELATION
TO DIVING WORK B.E. 2548 (2005)**

By virtue of Section 6 and Section 103 of the Labor Protection Act, B.E. 2541 (1998), which is the law that contains certain provisions in relation to the restriction of rights and liberty of the individual which are permitted under Section 29 together with Section 31, Section 35, Section 48 and Section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand, the Minister of Labor hereby issues the Ministerial Regulation as follows:

Clause 1

This Ministerial Regulation defines that;

"Diving work" means the work which is done under water by means of diving.

"Diver" means an employee who is skilled in diving work.

"Head of Diver" means a diver who is assigned by an employer to carry out all planning and supervising all diving works.

"Diver Escort" means the diver whose duty is to take care for and to give assistance to the diver in performing the diving work.

"Ready-to-Dive Diver" means the diver who is with readiness to dive and to help other divers who are performing the work underwater immediately in case of emergency.

"Controller of air-supply and communications" means the diver who is in charge of controlling of air supply system and communications with divers who are performing diving work.

"Pressure" means the pressure of water or of air which has effect on the body of a diver per one square unit area.
