

Ministerial Regulation No. 21, B.E. 2516 (1973)

Issued in Accordance with the Minerals Act, B.E. 2510

Translation

By virtue of Section 4 and Section 17 of the Minerals Act, B.E. 2510, as amended by the Minerals Act (No. 2), B.E. 2516, the Minister of Industry has issued the Ministerial Regulation as follows:

Article 1

The Ministerial Regulation No. 18 (B.E. 2516) issued under the Minerals Act, B.E. 2510 shall be repealed.

Article 2

This article was repealed and amended by the Ministerial Regulation No. 77 (B.E. 2539).

Article 3

This article was repealed and amended by the Ministerial Regulation No. 77 (B.E. 2539).

Article 4

Designate the followings as industrial soils:

- (1) Fire Clay
- (2) Diatomite or Diatomaceous Earth
- (3) Marl
- (4) Kaolinite
- (5) Ball Clay

Article 5

Designate glass sand and silica sand to be industrial sand.
