

The Customs Tariff Decree (No. 2), B.E. 2541 (1998)

Translation

BHUMIBOL ADULYADEJ, REX.

Given on the 2nd September B.E. 2541

Being the 53rd year of the present Reign.

By command of the King’s Most Excellent Majesty;

Whereas it is expedient to amend the law on customs tariff;

It is hereby, with the recommendation and approval of the Parliament, enacted as follows:

Section 1

This Decree shall be called “The Customs Tariff Decree (No. 2), B.E. 2541 (1998)”.

Section 2

This Act shall come into force as and from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Section 3

The details of the description column of heading 16 in Part IV, Goods Exempted from Payment of Duty, of the Customs Tariff Decree, B.E. 2530 shall be repealed and replaced by the following:
