

Notification of the Ministry of Commerce**Prescribing the application form and the form of license to operate a foreign business under Section 17, B.E. 2546 (2003)****Translation**

Whereas the Ministerial Regulation prescribing rules and procedures pertaining to the application for a license to operate a foreign business under Section 17, B.E. 2546 (2003) states that the Minister of Commerce shall prescribe the application form and the form of license to operate a foreign business under Section 17,

By virtue of the provisions in clause 1 and clause 10 of the Ministerial Regulation prescribing rules and procedures pertaining to the application for a license to operate a foreign business under Section 17, B.E. 2546 (2003), issued under the Foreign Business Act, B.E. 2542 (1999), which is an Act containing certain provisions relating to the restriction of rights and liberties of the people, which Section 29 in conjunction with Section 35 and Section 50 of the Constitution of the Kingdom of Thailand allow to be done by virtue of law, the Minister of Commerce hereby issues the Notification as follows:

Clause 1

This Notification is called "Notification of the Ministry of Commerce, Re: Prescribing the application form and the form of license to operate a foreign business under Section 17, B.E. 2546 (2003)".

Clause 2

This Notification shall come into force after the expiration of thirty days as from the date of its publication in the Government Gazette.

Clause 3

An application for a license to operate a foreign business under Section 17 shall be made in the application form Tor. 2 attached hereto.

Clause 4

A license to operate a business under Section 17 shall be in the form Tor. 3 attached hereto.
