In exercise of the power conferred by Section 14 (4) of the Petroleum Act, B.E 2514, the Minister of National Development hereby issues the following Ministerial Regulation:

The Schedule of Fees shall be as follows:

| (1) Concession Application Fee                                       | Baht 60 per application                    |
| (2) Surface Reservation Fee per square kilometer or fraction thereof | Baht 4,000 per annum                       |
| (3) Demarcation Survey Fee, by the length of traverses               | Baht 120 per kilometer or fraction thereof |
| (4) Boundary Mark onshore  | Baht 500 per mark                          |
