

**Ministerial Regulation No.11, B.E. 2524 (1981)**

**Establishing Safety Zones and Distance Marks for Onshore Petroleum Exploration and Production**

Issued under the provisions of the Petroleum Act, B.E. 2514

**Translation**

In exercise of the power conferred by Section 14 (2) of the Petroleum Act, B.E. 2514, the Minister of Industry hereby issues the following Ministerial Regulation: The provisions in paragraph 1 (1) and (2) of the Ministerial Regulation No.6, B.E. 2514 issued under the provisions of the Petroleum Act, B.E.2514 shall be hereby repealed and replaced by the following:

"(1) fence around the drilling rigs and other structures used in the petroleum exploration and production when they are more than thirty meters in highest above the ground level, by placing the fence at a distance of not less than sixty meters from the outer edges of such rigs and structures, in order to indicate that it is a safety zone. However in the case the distance should be greater due to the environmental condition and shape of the rigs and structures, the Director- General may on case by case basis prescribe such distance to be extended;

(2) maintain marks in alternate colors of red and white around the outer wall of the fence at every twenty meter distance and maintain a flag in orange color at the highest point of the rigs and structures under (1);"
