

Ministerial Regulation No.14, B.E. 2532 (1989)**Schedule of Fees**

Issued under the provisions of the Petroleum Act, B.E. 2514

Translation

In exercise of the power conferred by Section 14 (4) of the Petroleum Act, B.E. 2514, the Minister of Industry hereby issues the following Ministerial Regulation:

1. The Ministerial Regulation No.2, B.E. 2514 issued under the provisions of the Petroleum Act B.E. 2514 shall be hereby repealed.

2. The Schedule of Fees shall be as follows:

| (1) Application Fee | Baht 10,000 per application |
| (2) Surface Reservation Fee per square kilometer, a fraction thereof shall be prorated. | Baht 100,000 per annum |
| (3) Demarcation Survey Fee by the length of traverses | Baht 250 per kilometer or fraction thereof |
| (4) Boundary mark onshore | Baht 750 per mark |

3. Persons holding any concession prior to the date the Petroleum Act (No.4), B.E. 2532 comes into force and not being the persons who have been granted with the consent of the Minister under Section 36 of the aforesaid Act to be subject to the Petroleum Act, B.E. 2514 as amended by the Petroleum Act (No.4), B.E. 2532 shall pay the surface reservation fee at the rate specified in the concerned concessions of such concessionaires.
